ORDINANCE NUMBER ___267___

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Benton County Planning Commission on its own motion instituted proceedings to amend Ordinance Number 185 (Benton County Development Code), and any other ordinance, if any, amending Ordinance number 185, and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 1996, Notice of Public Hearings to Consider Amending the Benton County Development Code was published in the official newspaper and mailed to the governing bodies of all towns and municipalities located within Benton County; and

whereas, on October 10, 1996, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended to the Benton County Board of Commissioners that said amendments be approved; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1996, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and approved the proposed amendments,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BENTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS:

ARTICLE I

Add Section 3.108 to read as follows:

3.108 <u>Mini Storage (Self-Service Storage Facility):</u>

A structure containing separate, individual, and private storage spaces of varying sizes leased or rented on individual leases for varying periods of time.

However, the following uses are prohibited:

- 1. Auctions, commercial, wholesale, or retail sales, or miscellaneous or garage sales;
- 2. The servicing, repair, or fabrication of motor vehicles, boats, trailers, lawn mowers, appliances, or other similar equipment;
- 3. The operation of power tools, spray-painting

equipment, table saws, lathes, compressors, welding equipment, kilns, or other similar equipment (except for maintenance or repair of the structure);

4. The establishment of a transfer and storage

business;

5. Any use that is noxious or offensive because of odors, dust, noise, fumes, or vibrations; and

6. Any use of any portion as a dwelling or living facility.

ARTICLE II

Amend Sections 7.1.23 and 7.2.22 (<u>Conditional Uses</u>) to add "mini storage (self-service storage facility)" to the list of conditional uses in Agricultural Districts "A-1" and "A-2".
