The proposed changes dealing with individual sewage treatment systems are to bring the ordinance up to date with the changes adopted in Minnesota Rules 7080, October 1999, in an effort to regulate the proper disposal and treatment of domestic sewage and non-domestic waste in Benton County.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
