

**Statement of Evidence:**

**H081**

North Quarter Corner of Section 8, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

12" Blk Ash	N 6 ½ E	25 links
9" Blk Ash	S 50 W	9 links

2002 No record evidence was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2001 William Lunser, LS 9394, established corner as obliterated, based on evidence of north-south down fence and fence line west. He filed Certificate of Location (Doc. No. 283111), which gives distance of 2637.11 feet to the NW corner and 2627.76 feet to the NE corner of Section 8.

2008 Westwood Professional Services found a Cast Iron Monument (CIM) 22 feet east of a fence north and west. The CIM fits Lunser's distance within 0.1 feet east and west. Believing the CIM to be the best available evidence it is accepted as marking the corner position.
