

**Statement of Evidence:**

**H191**

North Quarter Corner of Section 19, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

13" Linden	N 27 ½ W	10 links
14" Blk Oak	S 51 ½ E	17 links

1939 County Engineer's Notebook No. 158 contains road survey for CAR No. 20 running east to west along the section line. Corner is shown as a spike set in center of road with fences north and south. Ties:

FP	N	21.5'
FP	NE	26.25'

Stationing gives distances of 2648.2 feet to the NE corner and 2616.7 feet to the NW corner with a delta angle of 0-32' left.

1979 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a ¾" iron pipe in center of east-west road and power line north-south. He set a cast iron monument and filed a Certificate of Location (Doc. No. 160208). His notes give a measurement of 2618.70 feet to the NW corner of Section 19.

2008 The County Surveyor's Office searched and found Wellen's 1979 cast iron monument along centerline of an east-west gravel road (County Road 43). Position gives a distance to the NW Cor. of 2618.59 ft. and a deflection (east to west) of 0°23'36"-left, which agrees with 1939 measurements. Thus, the cast iron monument is accepted as marking the best evidence. Ties were updated.
