

Statement of Evidence:

H072

Northeast Corner of Section 7, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

24" Elm	N 17 W	47 links
24" Bur Oak	S 88 E	80 links

1933 County Engineer's Notebook No. 72 contains survey of County road running south to north through this corner in center of road with fence line east. Ties:

F.P. East 32.8'

F.P. NE 39.1'

Stationing gives distances of 2656.7 feet to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Section 7 and 2642.7 feet to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Section 6 with a delta angle of 0-59' left.

1963 County Highway tie to spike:

F.P. East 47.3'

2009 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a 3/4" iron pipe. The found iron measures 2650.44 feet north to a found 3/4" iron pipe at the east quarter corner of Section 6, with the split of the distance at the sixteenth fitting a fence east within one foot. The iron measures 2652.29 feet south to a found railroad spike, with a split of the distance at the sixteenth fitting fences east and west within 3 feet.
