

Statement of Evidence:

H092

The Northeast Corner of Section 9, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

- 1915 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 465 and survey on Map No. 7 shows a survey by J.P. Soderstrum. Notes state that he found hole of original Elm BT, S 1 ½ W and fence line west at the corner. Measured 40.20 chains (2653.20 feet) to the East ¼ corner of Sec. 4.
- 1937 County Engineer's Notebook No. 99 contains a road survey for CAR No. 28 running south to north. Notes show corner marked by a granite monument in center town road east and fence line west with ties:

- Stationing gives distances of 2626.2 feet to the East ¼ corner Sec. 9 and 2663.6 feet to the East ¼ corner of Section 4.
- 1942 MN/DOT alignment map for TH 25 shows corner assumed at intersection of roads north, south, and east and fence line west with a distance of 2377.6 to point on tangent. Distance from East ¼ corner of Section 4 to this corner is 2725.30 feet.
- 1997 William Lunser, LS 9394, found a 40p spike in center of north-south road and fence line west. He did not accept the spike as the corner and set the corner midway between the East ¼ corners of Sections 4 and 9, with a distance of 2655.06 to each, being 26 feet north of the spike.
- 2007 The County Surveyor's Office excavated and found an 8" granite monument, apparently the same found in 1937. The stone falls 27.62 feet south of a found iron pipe capped 9394 and 2.6 feet southwest of a found rebar. The stone measures 2626.78 feet south to a 6" cut granite stone found at the east quarter corner of Section 9, fitting the 1937 distance within 0.6 feet and 5347.43 feet north to a half-inch iron pipe at the northeast corner of Section 4, fitting the 1937 distance within a foot. Ties were made to the stone. A 1/2-inch by 14-inch iron pipe capped 19552 was set to the mark the corner.

- 2009 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the 1/2-inch iron pipe set in 2007 and verified the 2007 coordinates.
