

Statement of Evidence:

H162

Northeast Corner of Section 16, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

14" Linden	N 70 W	21 links
10" Linden	S 60 E	14 links

1937 County Engineer's Notebook No. 99 contains a road survey for CAR No. 28 running south to north. Notes show corner marked by a spike with town road west and fence east. Ties:

Cor FP	NW	33.4
Cor FP	SW	33.4

1981 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " I.P. in the centerline of roads north-south and west. He replaced it with a cast iron monument. He filed a Certificate of Location (#160215).

2008 The County Surveyor's office found a Cast Iron Monument in the centerline of roads north-south and west. The position falls on the extension of line from the found granites north at the northeast and east quarter corners of Section 9 and fits the distance north to the east quarter corner within a foot and the angle within 4 minutes of the 1937 information. The CIM is accepted as marking the obliterated corner position.
