

**Statement of Evidence:**

**H212**

Northeast Corner of Section 21, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

20" Linden	N 83 W	11 links
7" Ironwood	N 34 E	10 links

1937 County Engineer's Notebook No. 99 contains a road survey for CAR No. 28 running south to north. Notes show corner marked by a spike with town road east and west. Ties:

Twin Boxelder	NE	37.4
FP	NW	49.3

1939 County Engineer's Notebook No. 158 contains road survey for CAR No. 20 running east to west along the section line. Corner is shown as a spike set in center of road intersection with CAR 28 running north-south. Ties:

FP	NE	47.0'
NW Cor Twp Hall	SE	61.8'

1981 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a 3/4" I.P. in the centerline of roads north/south and east/west. He replaced it with a cast iron monument. He filed a Certificate of Location (#160213). Notes give a distance of 2720.63 feet to the East 1/4 corner of Section 16. (Compares well with 1937 distance of 2719.4 feet.) Gives tie of 145.05 feet SW to the NE corner of town hall. (Assume town hall was moved.)
