

**Statement of Evidence:**

**H302**

Northeast Corner of Section 30, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

14" Ash	S 34 1/2 E	50 links
13" Bur Oak	N 44 W	59 links

1878 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 460, Richard Cronk notes a post is marking the corner for road survey.

1980 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, set an iron monument in the center of road intersection.

1992 Sidney Williamson, LS 10918, found a cast iron monument at the centerline of roads north/south and east/west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#213107).

2003 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found CIM per Certificate with ties as noted.

2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a CIM at the intersection of centerlines. The CIM measures within reason in all four directions. Since the 1878 survey used the corner post for the road survey, the CIM located at the intersection of centerlines is accepted as the obliterated corner location.
