Northeast Corner of Section 28, Township 36 North, Range 28 West, Glendorado Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1935 County Engineer's Notebook No. 92 contains survey for SAR No. 7 running north to south. Notes corner as a hub in center of TH 95. Ties:

- 1940's Roll E-4, of the MN/DOT Highway plans for TH 95, show the corner is marked by an I. Pin at the centerline of roads north/south and east/west, 2.93 feet north of new centerline and 2677.8 feet to the East ¼ corner of Sec 21 with the following reference ties.

- 1942 MN/DOT notes show a ½ " x 5" iron bolt was found and a 1" iron pipe was set over the bolt.

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- 1972 MN/DOT set iron pin from 1970 ties.
- 1997 James Nielson, LS 11865, found iron pin and 1972 reference ties and filed Certificate of Location (Doc. No. 261576)
- 2008 The County Surveyor's Office searched and found an iron pin and set a PK nail with a washer flush with the bituminous. Said position agrees with Nielson's 1997 ties. The position gives an overall distance of the north line of Section 28 as 5271.94 ft. and an overall distance of the north line of Section 27 as 5262.47 ft. Those distances agree with older surveys by M.B. Lang in 1929 (north line of Section 28) and Elletson in 1926 (north line of Section 27). Surveyor accepts Nielson's method and position and updated Nielson's ties from 1997.
