The Northeast Corner of Section 29, Township 36 North, Range 28 West, Glendorado Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

1942 MN/DOT notes call for field stone down 4.0 feet at intersection of east-west road and fence lines north-south.

1948 Roll O-11, of the MN/DOT Highway plans, show the corner is a 1/2" I.P set over a field stone at the centerline of a road east/west and a fence line north/south with the following reference ties.

Corner is 14.3 feet south of new centerline.

1949 MN/DOT recovered corner from 3 reference ties in 1942.

1966 MN/DOT notes call for an iron pin down 6" over field stone.

1970's Roll E-4, of the MN/DOT Highway plans, show the corner is marked by an I.P. is 14.3 ft south of new centerline with the following reference ties.

1970 MN/DOT notes call for iron pin with 3 iron pin reference ties prior to construction.

1972 MN/DOT notes show iron pin set after construction with additional ties.

1997 James Nielson, LS 11865, with MN/DOT recovered 3/4" iron pin and reference ties and set a cast iron monument. Filed Certificate of Location (No. 261578)
