

Statement of Evidence:

E021

North Quarter Corner of Section 2, Township 38 North, Range 32 West, West Langola Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office surveyor, Theodore Conkey, set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

12" Bur Oak N 66 1/2 E 417 links

16" Bur Oak S 13 1/2 W 500 links

A line tree is noted as an 8" Bur Oak, East, 18.40 chains

1877 Morrison County Surveyor's Book A, page 2, contains a survey by H.S. Clyde, which gives a distance of 40.44 chains (2669.04 feet) to the Northeast corner of Section 2.

1879 County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 1, contains a road survey by Richard Cronk that shows road from south terminating at this corner.

1977 On June 23, 1977 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a 1/2" iron pipe at the centerline of a road south and occupation to the west. A Certificate of Location was filed (#147085).

1989 On November 20, 1989 William Lunser set a cast iron monument over the 1/2" iron pipe and filed a Certificate of Location (#195970). He notes this corner is 2697.29 feet west of the NE Corner of Section 2.

2002 On June 5, 2002 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument. We found and checked with Lunser's ties and his distance to the NE corner of Section 2.
