North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

- 1919 Nels Peterson, Morrison County Surveyor, notes he set a concrete monument at all government corners along the south line of Lakin Township in Morrison County.
- 1994 On April 5, 1994, Kevin Festler, LS 22702, found a concrete monument with iron re-bar in the center. He prepared a Certificate of Location. He notes he accepted the corner found as the one set in 1919 by Peterson.
- 1995 Comstock and Davis performed GPS work under contract with Benton County and Coordinates Obtained by GPS NAD 83 (1986 Adjustment) to a CIM:

- 2004 Dan Kron, LS 42621, reported using corner for survey in Section 1.
- 2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a concrete monument with rebar as described by Nels Peterson in 1919. The found monument falls 3 feet west and 1.5 feet south of the lost position between a granite monument at the northeast corner of Section 1 and concrete monument at the northeast corner of Section 2. The concrete monument is accepted as marking the corner position.
