

**Statement of Evidence:**

**A041**

North Quarter Corner of Section 4, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.  
8" Blk Ash S 56 W 11 links  
8" Butternut N 50 E 35 links  
Line trees were noted as a 40" Pine East 16.60 chains and a 6" Pine West 19.65 chains.
- 1914 Morrison County Surveyor's Record Book A, on page 135 and page 158, shows a survey by Phil S. Randall of Section 33, 39-28 for laying out a town road running on north-south  $\frac{1}{4}$  line. This corner is shown marked by a stake set 2640 feet east of SW corner and 2640 feet west of the SE corner.
- 1919 Nels Peterson, Morrison County Surveyor, notes he set a concrete monument at all government corners along the south line of Lakin Township in Morrison County.
- 1982 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a cast iron monument at a fence line north/south and a fence line east/west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#173441) and notes a distance of 2644.27 feet to the NW corner Sec 4 and a distance of 2649.54 feet to the NE corner Sec 4.
- 2003 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found the CIM set by Lunser with the concrete monument set by Peterson lying flat on the ground along side and 2 feet east of the CIM. Accept the CIM as marking the position of where the concrete monument had been.
