

**Statement of Evidence:**

The North Quarter Corner of Section 6, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1919 Nels Peterson, Morrison County Surveyor, notes he set a concrete monument at all government corners along the south line of Lakin Township in Morrison County.
- 1986 Thomas Thiessen, LS 16097, with Comstock & Davis found a concrete monument marked with "1/4" on top and an iron pin in the center. Monument accepted as the one set by Peterson in 1919. Filed Certificate of Location in Morrison County (Doc. No. 307824).
