

Statement of Evidence:

A091

The North Quarter Corner of Section 9, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1939 County Engineer's Notebook No. 128 contains survey of CAR 22 running west to east on section line. Corner is shown in center of road and with town road north-south. Stationing gives distances of 2593.4 feet to the NE corner and 2589.9 feet to the NW corner.
- 1963 County Engineer's Notebook No. 249 contains survey of CSAH 22 running west to east on section line. Corner is shown as a spike set in center of road in line with town road south. Ties:

- Stationing gives distances of 2596.7 feet to the NE corner and 2586.5 feet to the NW corner with the point being a POT.
- 1982 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a cast iron monument at an occupation line north/south and a straight line between the NE and SE corners of Section 9. He filed a Certificate of Location (#173447). He notes a distance of 2586.50 feet to the NW corner Sec 9 and a distance of 2596.20 feet to the NE corner Sec 9.
- 2003 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a CIM and measured 2586.50 feet to the NW corner and 2596.22 feet to the NE corner of Section 9.
