

Statement of Evidence:

A121

The North Quarter Corner of Section 12, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

12" Elm	S 43 E	12 links
8" Sugar	N 9 W	27 links

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2004 Dan Kron, LS 42621, reported setting the corner lost, measuring 5303.65 feet between section corners. Corner falls in center of Co. Rd. 22 running east-west and in line with fence south. Ties:

PP (PK East Side)	NW	47.34'
Elm Cluster (PK in East Tree)	NE	76.3'
Cor. FP (PK West Side)	S	59.94'

2005 WSN found 1/2" iron pipe with cap No. 42621.

2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the 1/2" iron pipe capped 42621 down 0.3 feet below the road surface and verified the 2005 coordinate position. The found iron falls in the east-west centerline of CSAH No. 22 on a fence south and fits distances east and west proportionally. The iron is accepted as marking the corner position.
