

Statement of Evidence:

A361

North Quarter Corner of Section 36, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

14" Tamarack	S 66 W	36 links
10" Tamarack	N 27 E	29 links

1902 County Surveyor's Record Book 2, Page 358, and Record Book A, Map No. 37, shows a survey of Section 25 by John E. Whilt, which shows the south line of said section with each 40 acre parcel measuring 20.2 3/4 chains (5287.26 feet for the section) that indicates the corner was set lost.

2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. set a 1/2" iron pipe capped RLS #23002 by lost method, on line and midway between section corners. The position fell at the intersection of the centerline of 125th Street NE (running east and west) and a fence line (from the south) and an occupation line (from the north). Measured 5304.59 for the section line. On October 8, 2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found the 1/2" iron pipe capped RLS #23002 at the same location. Removed and set a cast iron monument and established reference ties.
