Northeast Corner of Section 3, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1914 Morrison County Surveyor's Record Book A, on page 159, shows a survey by Phil S. Randall of Section 34, 39-28. This corner is shown as a stake and stone.
- 1919 Nels Peterson, Morrison County Surveyor, notes he set concrete monuments at all government corners along the south line of Lakin Township in Morrison County.
- 2005 WSN found 10" x 10" concrete monument with rebar in the center.

- 2005 Kramer Leas DeLeo found the 10" x 10" concrete monument with rebar in the center in tact during a survey of the west line of Section 34, Twp. 39, Rng. 28 in Morrison County.
- 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo found the 10" x 10" concrete monument with rebar in the center sitting in a spoil pile. The property owner stated that their excavator had moved it during some site grading. The concrete monument was replaced to its original location, field ties were recorded, and a Certificate of Location of Government Corner was filed with Benton County and Morrison County.
- 2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the concrete monument with rebar, verified two remaining ties and verified the 2005 coordinates.
