

**Statement of Evidence:**

**A092**

Northeast Corner of Section 9, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

22" Pine	N 42 E	20 links
16" Sugar	N 33 W	22 links

1922 County Engineer's Notebook No. 30 shows same ties as in No. 37 below with corner being iron monument in center of road.

1924 County Engineer's Notebook No. 37 shows survey of SR No. 7 running from the south to this corner with ties:

6" Ash	SE	67.0'
8" Pop.	NE	53.1'

1939 County Engineer's Notebook No. 128 contains survey of CAR 22 running west to east on section line and terminating at this corner. Corner is shown in center of SAR No. 7.

193? County Highway notes: H. G. Elletson refers to a hub with the following reference ties, as does Kotsmith in 1968.

SW Cor gas pumps	NE	86.0
P.P.	SE	102.0

1960 County Engineer's Notebook No. 231 contains survey for CSAH 7 running south to north on section line. Notes show iron in center of CSAH 22. Same ties as listed above. County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 326, refers to an iron with the previous reference ties.

1963 County Engineer's Notebook No. 249 contains survey of CSAH 22 running west to east on section line. Corner is shown as an iron in center of 4-way road intersection. Same ties as above plus:

P.P.	NW	70.5
T.P.	SW	51.2

1982 William Lunser, LS 9394, found a 1" iron pin at the intersection of the centerlines of two County Roads. Removed the 1" iron pin and set a cast iron monument and established reference ties and a Certificate of Location (#173444).

2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 7 (running north and south) and County Road 22 (running east and west). We established reference ties.
