

Statement of Evidence:

A322

Northeast Corner of Section 32, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

18" B. Oak	N 76 W	18 links
9" B. Oak	N 35 W	23 links

1930 County Engineer's notebook No. 56 contains a road survey by H. G. Elletson for CAR No. 27. Notes show road survey run south to north along section line. Town road east. Corner marked by a hub with ties:

F. P.	NE	42.8'
12" W. Oak	SW	62.1'

1958 County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 372 notes an iron was placed at the corner with the following reference ties.

P.P.	SE	65.65
6" W. Oak	SW	58.35

Older ties to hub:

F.P.	NE	42.8
12" W. Oak	SW	62.1

2000 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a flat iron at the corner.

2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a bent fence post over the remains of a hub at the intersection of the centerlines of Township Road 67 (running north and south) and 125th Street NE (from the east). Removed and set a cast iron monument at the location and established reference ties.
