

**Statement of Evidence:**

**K162**

Northeast Corner of Section 16, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees:

10" Aspen	S 15 E	148 links
5" Aspen	N 13 W	43 links

1931 County Engineer's Notebook No. 61 contains road survey that shows corner marked by hub and iron with ties:

T.P.	SE	38.6'
Cor. F. P.	NE	38.3'

Notes show road east and fence line west. Notation in 1957 shows corner found.

1933 County Engineer's Notebook No. 67 shows road survey by H. G. Elletson running east-west. Corner is shown as an iron and hub at PI with road north-south with ties:

T.P.	SE	38.6'
Cor. FPNE		38.3'

1962 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 115, notes a hub and an iron with the following reference ties:

Sign Pst	NE	46.0
PP	NW	45.3
TP	SE	58.0

1974 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 101, notes a hub and an iron monument with the following reference ties:

Cor FP	W	32.4
PP	NW	45.3

1986 Benton County Highway records note a large nail was set on the centerlines of County Road 62 and County Road 50.

1992 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a nail and replaced it with a cast iron monument and filed a Certificate of Location (#216289).

2008 The County Surveyor's Office searched and found a cast iron monument at the intersection of the centerline of north-south 105<sup>th</sup> Ave. N.E. (County Road No. 62) and east School House Road (County Road No. 50) and is on line with a fence line to the west. Position agrees with 1962 ties to power pole and sign. The Surveyor accepts the CIM position and ties were updated.
