

**Statement of Evidence:**

**K321**

The North Quarter Corner of Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post with bearing trees:

6" Blk Oak	S 2 W	18 links
6" Blk Oak	N 22 ½ W	453 links

1990 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a cast iron monument at a fence line north/south/east. He filed a Certificate of Location (#201535).

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2008 The County Surveyor's Office searched and found the cast iron monument as set by Lunser in 1990. Position falls at the intersection of old fencelines running north-south and east. Distances to the NW Cor. and NE Cor. measure 2631.74 ft. and 2629.06 ft., respectively. The Surveyor accepts the corner as marking the obliterated position and updated ties.
