

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G053**

East Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

12" Blk Oak	N 19 W	209 links
6" Aspen	N 19 E	100 links

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2009 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1/2-inch iron pipe capped 9394 at the intersection of down fences from the east and south. The distance south fits the GLO distance within 10 feet and the distance north is 150 feet long of the GLO distance. Many closing distances along the north line of the townships are measure extremely long in Benton County. Believing the found pipe and down fences to the east and south to be the best available obliterated evidence, the pipe was left in place, located and reference ties were taken as shown.
