

Statement of Evidence:

G252

Northeast Corner of Section 25, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4th Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

8" Blk Oak	N 53 E	29 links
6" Blk Oak	N 51 W	13 links
12" W Birch	S 10 E	10 links
10" Blk Oak	S 60 W	42 links

Line trees were noted as a 8" W Birch, North, 20.68 chains and a 6" W Oak, South, 20.73 chains.

Undated Reference ties:

PP	NE	50.9

1992 Sidney Williamson, LS 10918, found a 6" spike and set a cast iron monument in its place, at the centerline of roads east/west/south. He filed a Certificate of Location (#213103).

2010 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the CIM in place at the intersection of roads. The half mile measurement north is 2676.77 and south is 2623.77 feet. The 2004 coordinates were verified.
