

**Statement of Evidence:**

**L362**

The Northeast Quarter Corner of Section 36, Township 36 North, Range 30 West, Minden Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

8" Bur Oak S 88 1/2 W 872 links

8" Bur Oak N 39 W 272 links

- 1930 County Engineer's Notebook No. 60 and County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 231, notes a hub at the corner with the following reference ties.

Cor F.P. E 25.8

F.P. NE 44.9

Notes show fence line east and a delta angle of 0-30' right (running south to north).

- 1990 William Lunser, LS 9394, found a 1/2" iron pin at the intersection of a fence line to the East, a field line to the West and the centerline of County Road 25 (running north and south). Replaced with a cast iron monument. He notes that the distance to the East 1/4 Corner of Section 25 is 2681.78 feet and the distance to the South 1/4 Corner of Section 30 is 2821.74 feet. A Certificate of Location (#201529) was recorded.

- 2001 In August 2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument at the centerline of County Road 25 (running north and south) and occupation to the east and the west. No evidence found of GLO or 1930 ties.
