



Benton County Notice of Mail Ballot Procedures-2020 General Election November 3, 2020

Benton County Mail Ballot Precincts:

- Langola Township
- City of Gilman
- City of Royalton(within Benton county)
- City of Sauk Rapids Precinct 6

Registered voters within the above-mentioned precincts will automatically be sent a mail ballot for the November 3rd General Election by non-forwardable mail to their home address as long as they are registered by the 21st day before the election.

The first mailing will be sent October 6th. Please allow extra time for delivery.

Non-Registered voters can either update their voter registration on or before October 13th

Voters in a mail ballot precinct may vote absentee in-person at the Benton County Auditor-Treasurer's office during normal business hours; Monday through Friday from 8AM-4:30PM starting September 18th. In addition, our office will be open from 10:00AM-3:00PM on Saturday, October 31st and 8:00AM-5:00PM on Monday, November 2nd.



If voters in one of the above-mentioned mail ballot precincts need to cast a vote on election day-November 3rd; the polling place is:

Election Day Voting Hours: 7:00AM-8:00PM

An AutoMark assistive voting device will be available which allows persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently.

Voters must follow the instructions enclosed with their ballot and return the ballot to the Benton County Auditor-Treasurer's office by mail (prepaid postage return envelope will be enclosed when the ballot is mailed) or hand-delivered.

- **If Hand-Delivered:** Must be dropped off by **3pm** on Election Day-**November 3rd**. Either hand the ballot directly to a staff member in the Auditor-Treasurer's office or placed in the secure drop box to the right of the front door at 531 Dewey St Foley, MN
- **If Mailed:** Ballots **postmarked** on or before Election Day **and received** by the county by the close of business the day before the county canvass will be counted.
