Reminder: Twelve annual training hours are required for each license holder. Of the twelve hours, each license holder must have a minimum of one hour specific to a children's mental health topic, and one hour specific to Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders. If newly licensed, there is a specific FASD training video that is required. Ask the licensor if you require additional information. As needed, consult the licensor with questions about what may qualify as training hours. Provide training certificates, if applicable. It is best practice to keep copies for your own records. Complete one training record per license holder (two enclosed); unless all training has been completed jointly, then one shared record may be used. **See back of form for links to access online training resources and other information on verifying training.** The Foster Care Support Network Volumes are also available by request.
